Local Child Care Resource & Referral Services for All Parents

Ages of Children for Care Requested

64% of care requested was for infants and toddlers

23% of care requested was for preschool age children

13% of care requested was for school-age children

Type of Care Requested by All Families

67% of care requested was for center based programs

33% of care requested was for family child care programs

Where are ALL the Children in Care?

- 31% of children in care are in full time center based programs
- 30% of children in care are in before/after-school programs
- 24% of children in care are in part-time center programs
- 15% of children in care are in family child care homes

Statewide Capacity

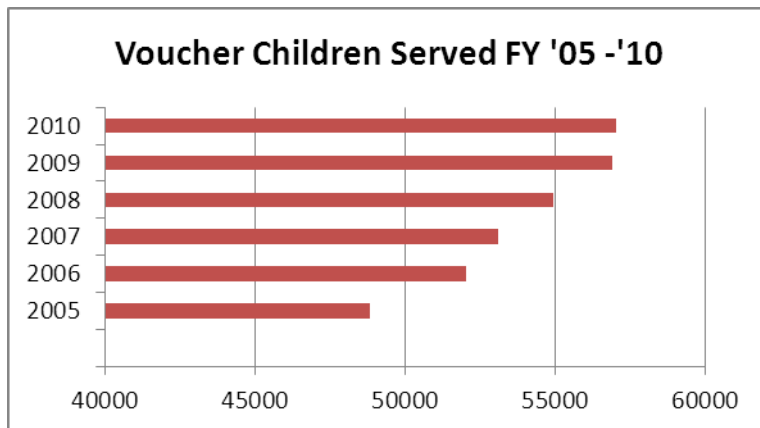
Total statewide capacity of all legally operating early education and care programs in MA, including public schools, subsidized and non-subsidized providers **293,463**

Facts About

Local CCR&R Voucher Services:

- ✓ **57,023** children received child care vouchers
- ✓ **\$251 million** dollars were efficiently managed & distributed to voucher providers by MCCR&Rs in FY '10
- ✓ **34%** increase in voucher subsidy dollars managed over FY '05



- ✓ **17%** increase in voucher children served since 2005
- ✓ **100%** of the MCCR&R access management services are **reimbursed** by the Federal Government
- ✓ **21,000** children were on the EEC waitlist for subsidized child care as of December 2010
