For over 30 years, the CCR&R staff of early care & education professionals have worked to support quality child care in MA by supporting accreditation & quality improvement programs, leading the state in the fiscal management of the child care financial subsidy system so all families have access to quality child-care and advocated for better compensation for providers to help improve the quality of care for all children in MA.

Provided families with **270,960** referrals to Massachusetts child care businesses

Maintain fiscal oversight for the **5,267** licensed child care educators and license exempt programs who provide care for children with vouchers

Collect and maintain up-to-date data on almost **10,000** programs across the Commonwealth

48% of children in care are in full time center based programs

25% of children in care are in before/after-school programs

13% of children in care are in part-time center programs

14% of children in care are in family child care homes

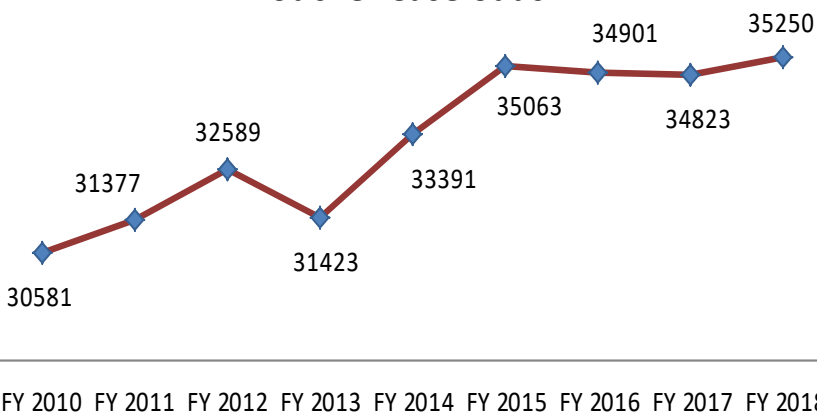

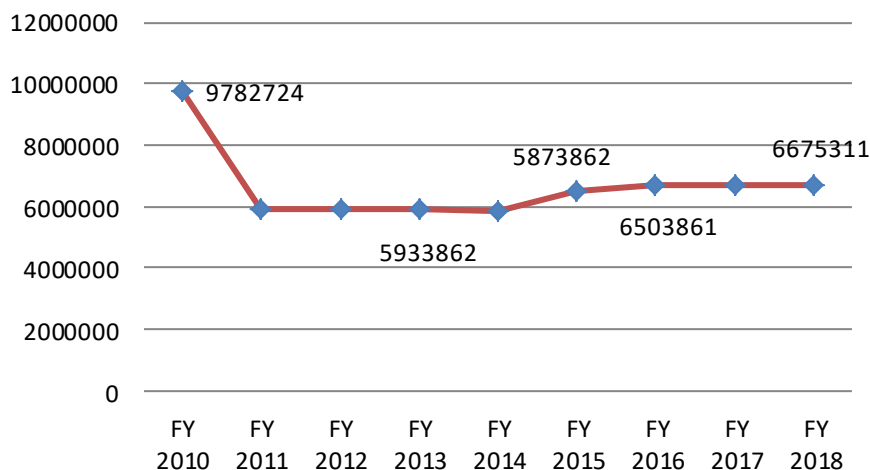
Voucher Child Care in Massachusetts: A Profile

- ✓ **Massachusetts** average voucher caseloads are **648** per CCR&R family specialist as compared to the national best practice of **250**
- ✓ **281M** dollars were distributed through the CCR&Rs to child care businesses in Massachusetts
- ✓ **100%** of the CCR&R access management services are **reimbursed** by the Federal Government
- ✓ **CCR&Rs** assist **50** Family Child Care systems representing over **2500** family child care educators servicing voucher families .
